



PROGRESS ON THE SHOP/CAFE PROJECT

A Project Committee was set up in early 2014 by local residents to pursue options to enable the much loved local shop and cafe to have a secure future .

The Project Committee is pleased to report that the Trustees of the Clapham Recreation Ground have consented to a replacement building in place of the existing premises serving our community– subject to legal review. They are, however, proposing a number of conditions. The Trustees wish to make it clear that they have never said 'no' to all or any changes. The Project Group look forward to further fruitful discussions with the Trustees in order to secure a new building which is fit for purpose.

This represents an exciting and welcome development for everyone who supports the Project.

In the meantime we have reviewed timescales and a full planning application needs to be prepared soon to fit in with deadlines imposed by the Planning Authority and Arun District Council. With this in mind a further public meeting will be convened in order to inform everyone concerned of the proposals and to seek comment before we go ahead. We will let you know the meeting date just as soon as we can.
