PROGRESS

An informal meeting has already been held with the Trustees of the Clapham Recreation Ground to inform them of the need for change. We are keeping the Trustees informed and ultimately their agreement will be needed if a new or modified building is to be provided on the existing site.

Arun Environmental Health have also attended a meeting to discuss what is needed by way of food preparation facilities, drainage and a unisex/disabled toilet to serve the premises.

We have started to look at building construction options including the use of straw bales, log cabin, prefabricated and conventional designs and are seeking the order of costs.

We will shortly be contacting the SDNPA Planners to gain an idea of what might be acceptable to them.

FUNDRAISING EVENTS

The main reason why a community-led project like this is feasible is that it potentially will attract grants from philanthropic bodies and also local authorities, as it is recognised that local facilities are important to retain social cohesion in small communities. The current operation is too small to enable direct funding by way of business loans.

BUT - substantial fundraising is going to be essential as there is likely to be a large

shortfall. We will only be able to provide what is affordable.

WE ARE HOPEFUL that a musical event can be held locally in early September to raise money and are also looking at other ideas. If you think you can help with fundraising either ideas or action please contact Yvette on the number given on page 1.
