Responses included: Keep it as it is; don't build on it; prevent inappropriate development sensitive building; better parking

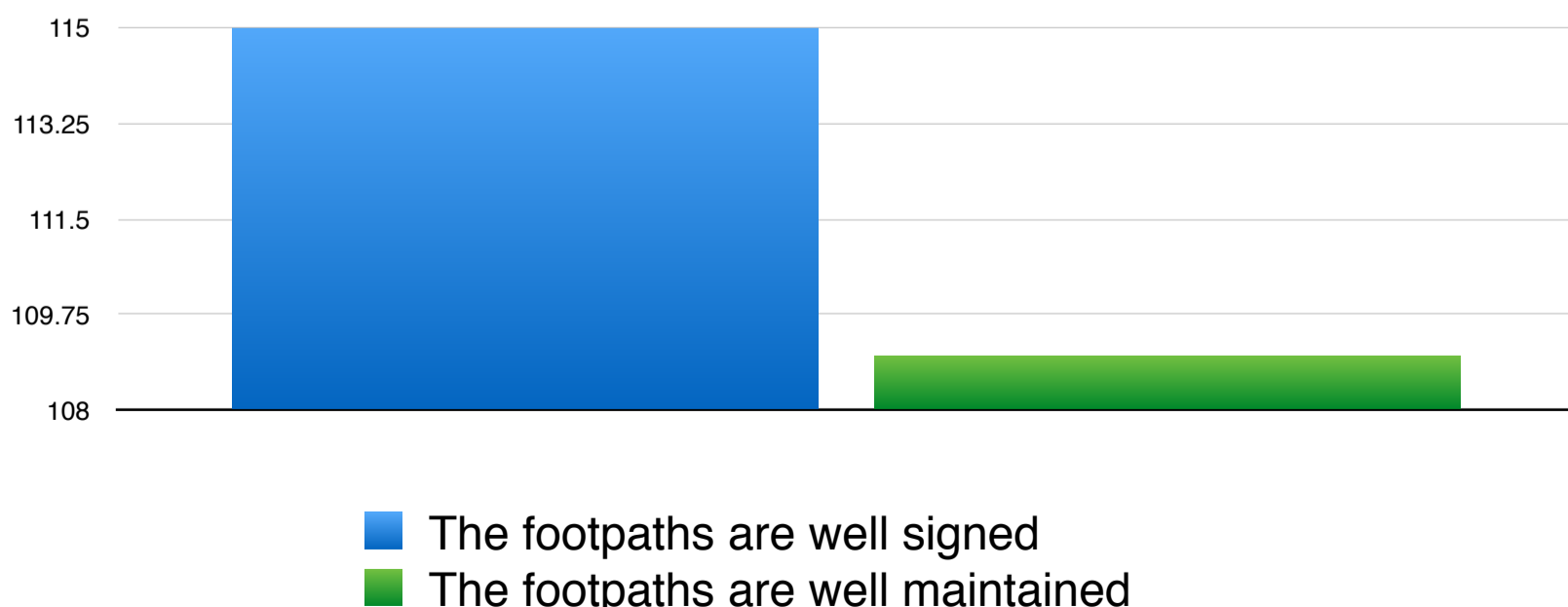
4. What changes, if any, would you like to see on the Rec. (The Street)?

Responses included: new play equipment; more parking; no dogs; larger cafe and shop

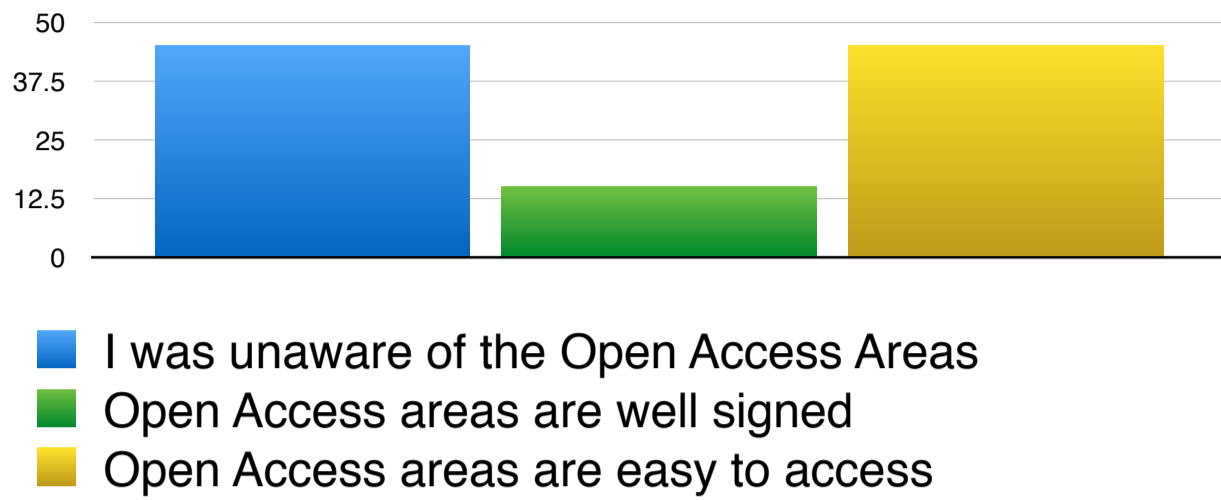
5. What would you like to see happen to the former BMX track?

Responses included: give it to the cubs and scouts; bee hives; wildlife habitat; nature trail, new BMX track

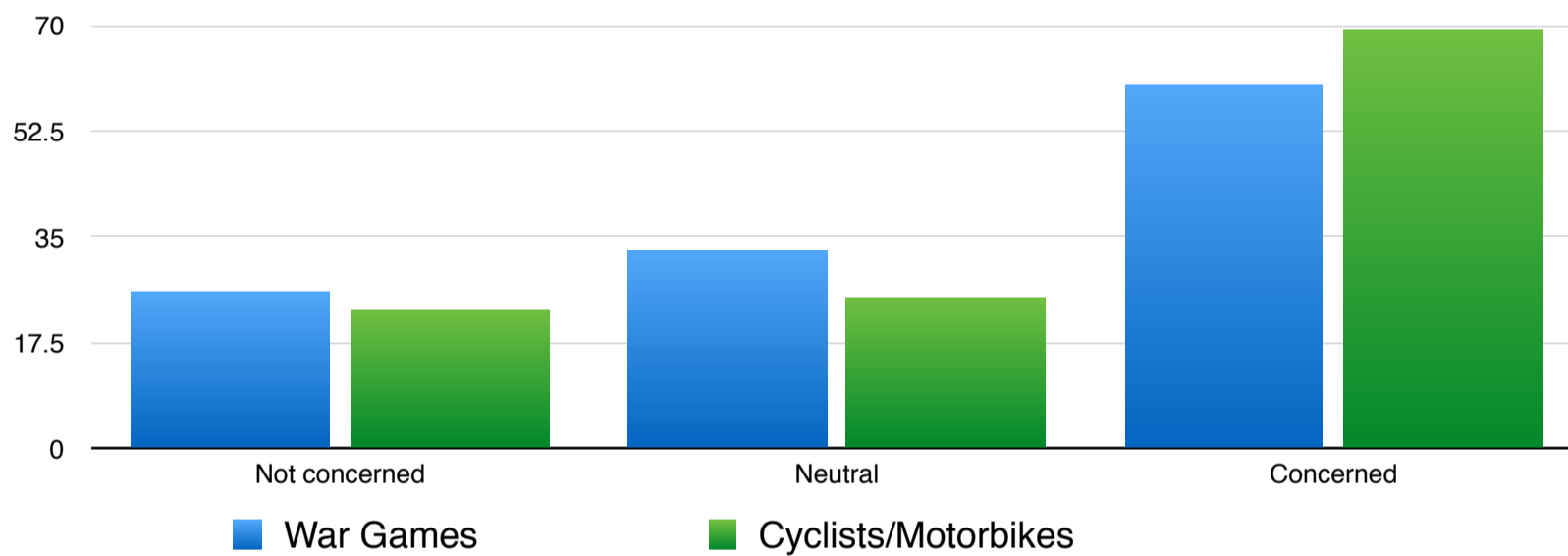
6. What do you think about the network of footpaths across the fields and woodland?



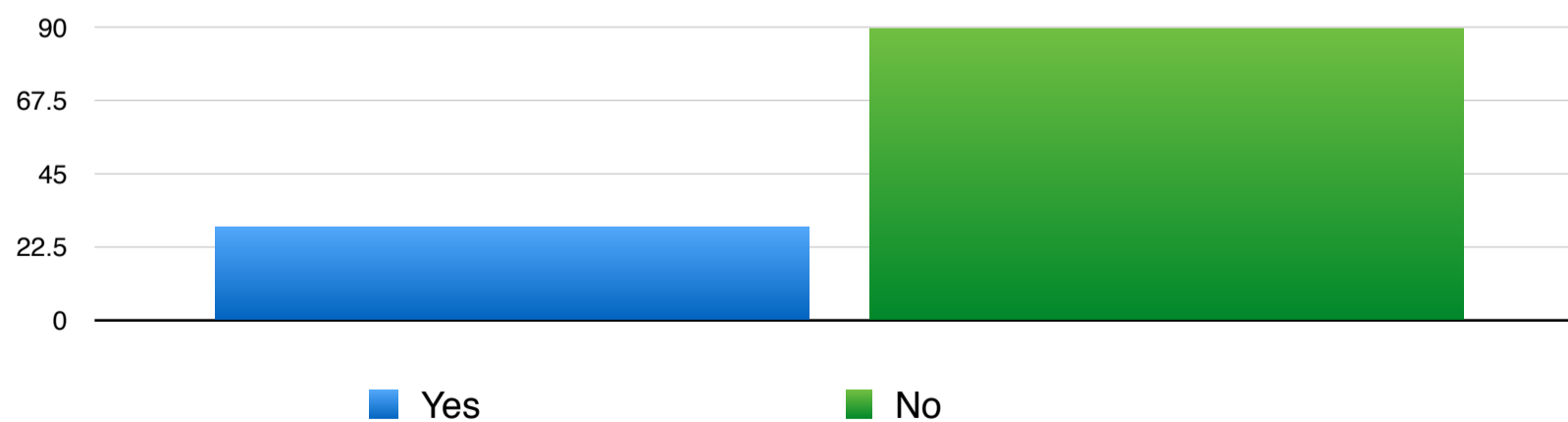
7. What do you think about the areas of Open Access land in the parish?



8. What do you think about the activities that take place in the woodlands (bearing in mind that they are all privately owned)?



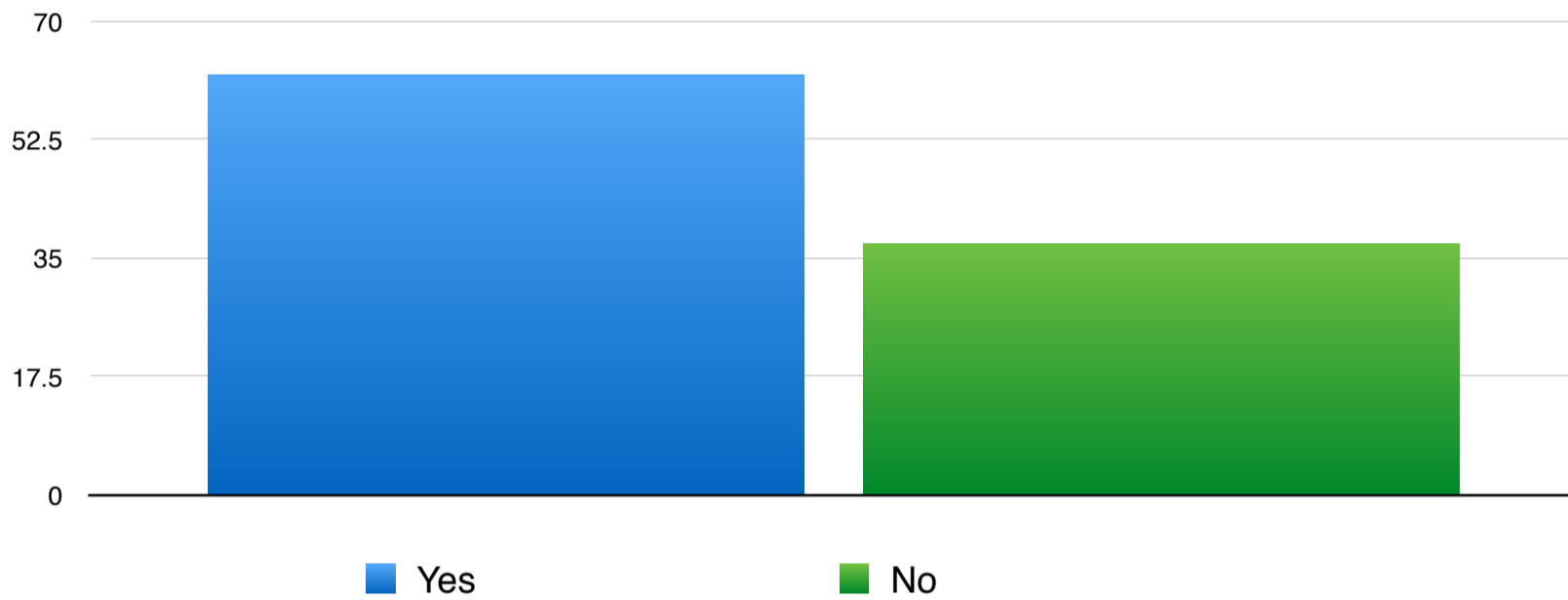
9. Have you experienced problems with highway drainage?



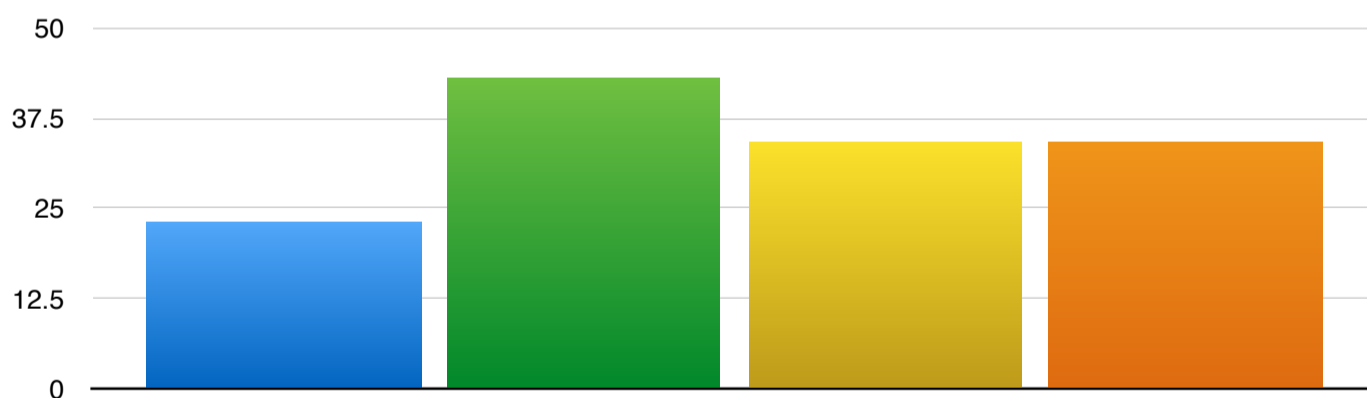
10. If yes, where?
